EAU CLAIRE, WI: The Pablo Center at the Confluence is thrilled to announce an exciting lineup of events coming up in the next few months that promise to captivate, entertain, and inspire audiences of all ages. With a diverse variety of entertainment scheduled, there is something for everyone to enjoy at Pablo Center.

Musician in Residence [Coming June 9, 16, 23, and July 12, 2024] — Embedded within Pablo Center's renowned performing arts venue is a brand new "Musician in Residence" program. This is a unique experience in Eau Claire for artists working in music, sound, composition, and voice. The "Musician in Residence" program gives artists time to develop new ideas, work on projects, expand collaborations, and explore their practice. Artist residencies are not uncommon in the music world at large, but are a rare model for Eau Claire specifically. Carey. Over three Sunday evenings in June and a final Friday performance in July, S. Carey will be joined by friends local & not-so-local to perform takes on the S. Carey discography alongside more improvisational explorations. Each of these four shows will be wholly unique featuring different setlists played with different guest musicians, and it's all taking place in the area's newest ALL AGES listening room, the Robert Manz Gibson Street Entry. We Are the Willows (solo) & The Nunnery [Coming June 14, 2024] — The Nunnery begins with one voice, layered upon itself becoming a lush soundscape. Sarah Elstran is an independent musician that bridges the gap between bright-eyed pop composition and hands-on atmospheric live layering of voice. Her vocal loops give us the kind of detail and wide multi-octave range that we might come to expect from a marquee pop star, while her production decisions continually keep us guessing as to what rabbit holes her tracks might fall into next.
